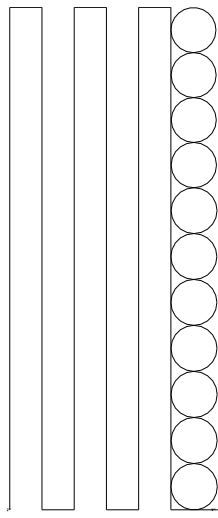


These borders are not repeatable automatically. There are several lengths of the two borders you need to determine your length and lay them in manually. I did this so you do not get any over stitching at the bottom of the border or sash. Use the longest one as much as you can then determine which one you need to finish out the border or sash see layout on following page to see how the corners go together... I think this is actually easier especially on those wonky borders. The only difference between the two is the distance apart each circle is.

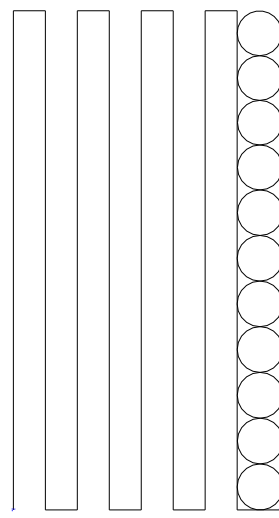




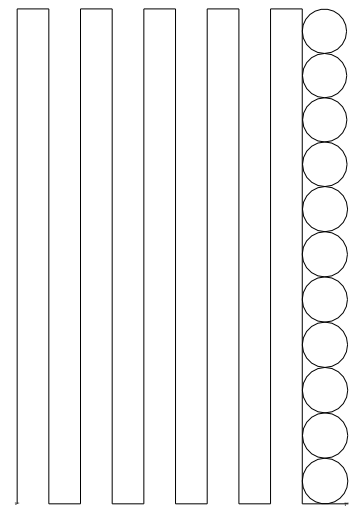

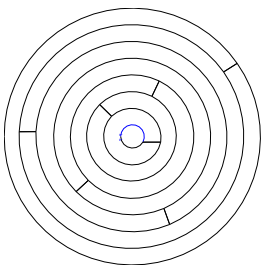

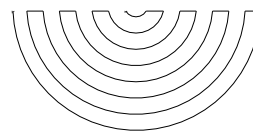

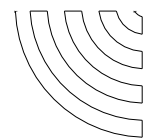
Full circle curved lines



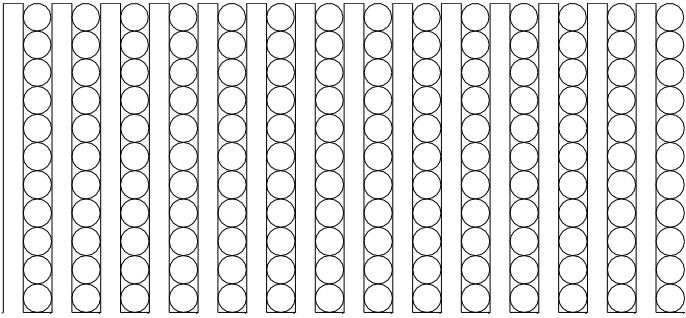
Three quarter circle

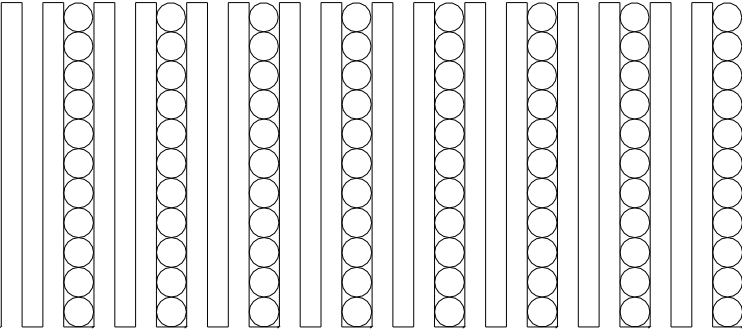

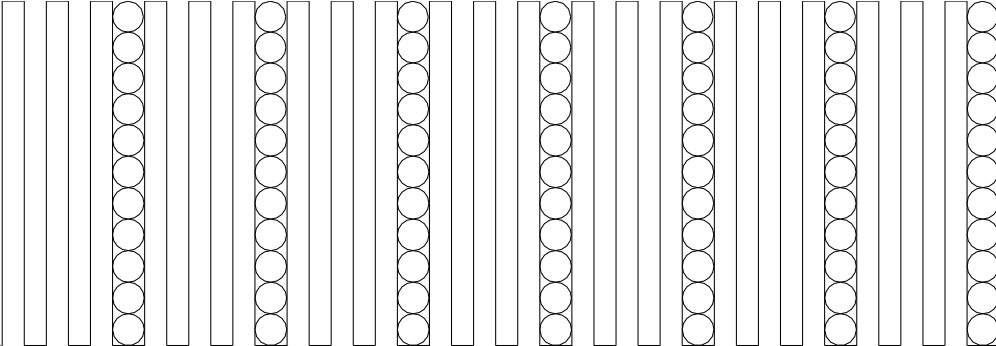

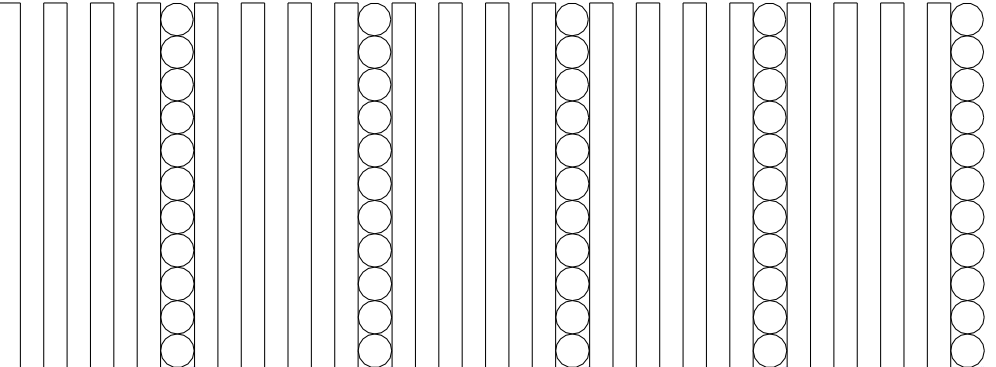
Modern Border 1 Layout



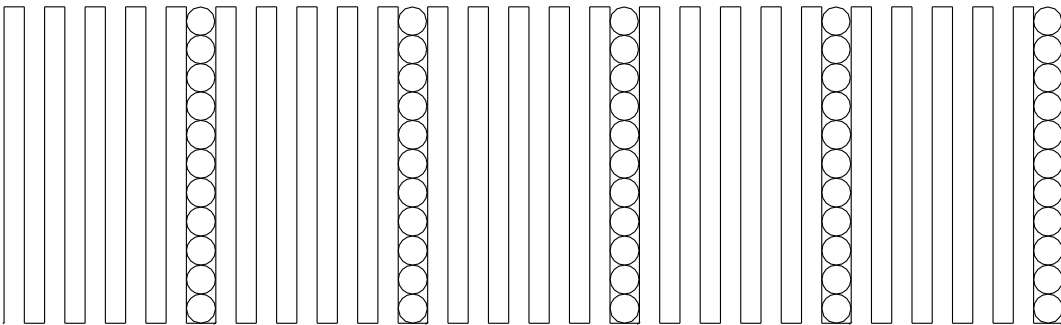
